Mr. Leopold died Tuesday in a local nursing facility.

A native of Mansfield, Louisiana, he was born June 10, 1924 and had lived in San Antonio for several years and in Longview area for the past 20 years. Mr. Leopold graduated from Jefferson High School in San Antonio and he attended Tulane University and graduated from the University of Texas Pharmacy School. He was a registered pharmacist having worked for Louis Morgan Drug, Longview and K&B Drug in Marshall, TX. Mr. Leopold served his country during World War II in the US Army infantry in Europe where he received numerous medals including the Purple Heart.
