Burial will follow in Jordan Valley Cemetery. A Rosary will be recited at 7 PM Sunday, December 1, 2002 in the Chapel of the Rader Funeral Home of Longview, 1617 Judson Rd.

Mr. Weierich was born September 12, 1929 to Andrew and Marie-Jeanne Weierich. He passed away on Thursday afternoon, November 28, 2002 in a Longview medical center.

He graduated from the University of California at Berkeley with a Bachelor's Degree in Plant pathology, received his Masters in Philosophy at St. Mary's College in Moraga, CA. and his PhD in History and Philosophy of Science from Oregon State University. He was a Chemistry professor at Texas A & M, taught nursing students, Anatomy and Physiology in Appalachia at Sue Bennett College and Eastern Kentucky State University and for a short time taught nursing students at Kilgore Junior College.

A loving husband, father and grandfather, Mr. Weierich was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife, Mary Weierich; daughters, Teresa Wilder, Mariann Weierich; son, John Weierich and grandchildren, Collin Patrick Wilder, Alex James Wilder and Vanessa Weierich.
