John was born in Coleman, TX to John Francis and Ella Cash on June 6, 1925. He was raised in Coleman and entered the military service in 1942. He served in the U.S. Navy receiving an honorable discharge as a Sonarman Third Class. As an Army Reservist, he was ranked as Squadron Leader before being honorably discharged. He primarily resided in Longview, Texas working at Kodak, Screw & Bolt, and retiring at Crown, Cork & Seal. John is remembered as a loving husband, a devoted father and a great friend to those who knew him. He loved his family, his friends and his friends and his guns foremost.
