Burial will be in Okmulgee Cemetery in Okmulgee, OK., at 10 AM Tuesday, June 10. Services are under the direction of Rader Funeral Home of Longview. Visitation will be from 2 to 4 PM Sunday at the funeral home. Mr. Hixon went to be with his Lord and Savior on Thursday, June 5, 2003, at his residence in Longview, Texas. Jim was born September 13, 1930 in Seminole, OK to Wayne Jesse Hixon and Lavera Chrystal Goins Hixon. He was married February 2, 1952 to Helen Grace Moravits. They were happily married for 52 years. He worked most of his life in the oil patch, and retired from Axelson, Inc., now owned by Halliburton, in 1997 after 35 years service. He attended school at Prairie View Schools and graduated from Seminole High School. After several years in college, he enlisted in the Air Force in 1950, and obtained the rank of Staff Sergeant and finished his tour of duty in 1954.
