**F**uneral services for Harold Vincent Green, 82, of Longview, will be 2 PM Tuesday in the Chapel of Rader Funeral Home, 1617 Judson Rd. Interment will follow in Roselawn Cemetery in Mineola at 4:15 PM .

Mr. Green died Thursday, April 17, 2004 in a local medical center.

Mr. Green was born December 31, 1921 in Nelsonville, Ohio. He had been a resident of Longview since 1995 moving from Weatherford, TX where he lived for 15 years before moving from Ft. Worth.
