Funeral services for Ephram Elven "Pete" Black, 83, of Longview will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday, September 7, 2005, in the Chapel of Rader Funeral Home with the Reverends A. D. Spears and Charles Chargois officiating. Burial will be in Lakeview Memorial Gardens. Mr. Black passed away Sunday, September 4, in a Shreveport hospital.

Visitation will be from 6 to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home.

Mr. Black was born August 2, 1922 in Centerville, Arkansas to Manuel and Bertha Black. He had been a resident of Longview since 1971, moving from Hot Springs. He was a retired self employed carpenter and a WWII veteran of the U. S. Army. He was a member of the Pentecostal Church and the Disabled American Veterans.
