Jim and Carolyn married June 28, 1950 and just celebrated their 54th anniversary. Jim completed his Air Force career in 1970 and Carolyn too completed her career as a successful Air Force wife. After retirement, the family of four moved to Longview. Carolyn gained employment with Longview Independent School District and recently retired after 34 years of faithful service.
