Funeral services for Tommy C. Boswell, 69, of Kilgore, will be 2 PM Friday, March 10, at Bright Holland Funeral Home Chapel, Paris, TX, with Reverend James Singleton officiating. Interment will follow in Evergreen Cemetery, Paris, Texas.

Tommy fought the good fight against cancer with courage and dignity until his death on March 7, 2006.

He was a 1956 graduate of Paris High School, owned and operated several small businesses in Paris before relocating to Longview in 1979 to begin a new business venture, Kleen Sweep, which his wife Joan, continues to operate.
