Julian B. "Jack" Smith passed away May 18, 2006 at the Good Shepherd Medical Center in Longview, TX. He was born in Kilgore, TX on April 3, 1927 to Samuel and Gladys Goforth Smith. He was preceded in death by both his parents and his brothers, Truman and Donald Smith. He grew up on the family farm on Goforth Road in Gregg County and was a graduate of Sabine School in Liberty City. He was a WWII U. S. Navy veteran. Mr. Smith, known to many as "Sundown", had a long career as a heavy equipment operator beginning in the early 1950's and retired at the age of 75 from Marion County Pct. 1.
