Their senior year they led their school to the State Track Meet running the mile. After graduating high school, he and Larry went on to Stephen F. Austin, where he graduated with a Bachelors in Economics. During his college years, he met the love of his life, Sandra. At the skating rink in Marshall, she won his heart with just a smile and a wink--A true love story, united in marriage October 16, 1964.
