Mrs. Brown passed away Friday December 21, 2007 at her residence.

Christine was born in the Liberty Community Frog Pond on December 20, 1916. She was the 5th of nine children born to the late Robert Young Allen, Martha Parks Toon Allen. Christine was a lifelong resident of Rusk County, and was raised in Tatum Texas.
