Services for Brother Emery Waddell , 74, of Longview will be held 10 AM Friday at the Carraway-Claybar Funeral Home in Huntington, Texas. Burial will follow at 2 PM in the Holland Cemetery near Kountz, Texas. Visitation will be Thursday afternoon at Rader Funeral Home, 1617 Judson Rd. 6 to 8 PM. Brother Waddell died Wednesday morning at a local medical center.

He was born Oct. 23, 1923 in Village Mills, Texas to Ira Brack and Hester Green Waddell. A former resident of Huntington, he had resided in Longview for three years. For many years, he served as a minister for Missionary Baptist Churches in a number of locations. He was actively involved with the Hiway 80 Rescue Mission in Longview and had directed many jail and prison ministries over the years. He was also retired from Lufkin Industries.
