# **H**ORACE BEALL

Services for Horace Beall , 79, of Longview will be noon Saturday, December 20th at Rader Funeral Home Chapel with Ritchie Hamm officiating. Burial will follow at Stewart Cemetery in Rusk County. Mr. Beall died Wednesday evening at a local hospital.

He was born September 8, 1929 in Rusk County, Texas to Walter C. and Lillian Armstrong Beall. A resident of Longview since 1940, he was a member of the Pine Tree Church of Christ, he served in the 82nd Airborne Division of the U. S. Army during Korea. In the early 1970's, he was appointed by The White House to serve on the Joint Committee on Defense Production.
