White Oak- Utah Carroll McAlister, 80, of White Oak passed away peacefully in his sleep April 27, 2009. Mr. McAlister was born May 19, 1928, in Cotton Valley, Louisiana. He was a resident of White Oak for nearly 45 years.

He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Margaret McAlister.
