Vernon Haylan Beavers, 81, of Longview, Texas went to be with the Lord on Monday, May 11, 2009 surrounded by his loved ones. The family will receive friends at Radar Funeral Home on Wednesday, May 13, 2009 from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. Services will be officiated by the Rev. David English on Thursday, May 14, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. in the Ford Chapel at First Baptist Church of Longview. Graveside services will follow at Roselawn Cemetery in Mineola, Tx at 4 PM.

He was born on July 31, 1927 in Brandon, Texas to Wayland and Jessie Beavers. Vernon graduated from Paschal High School in Fort Worth, Texas. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy during World War II. Following his return from the war, he went to work for the Texas & Pacific Railroad in Mineola. He retired in 1987 after 38 years of service with the railroad. Vernon was a member of First Baptist Church Longview, served on the Texas Pacific Credit Union Board of Directors for several terms and was a member of Masonic Lodge No. 502 in Mineola for 53 years.
