**F**uneral services for Lela Catherine "Kate" Warren Alexander, age 95 of New London, are scheduled for 2:00pm Thursday March 4, 2010 in the Chapel of Rader Funeral Home in Henderson, with Pastors Johnny Wright and Don McPherson officiating.
