The years in between were merely preparation for this Heavenly journey and marked by dedication, commitment, consideration, devotion, enthusiasm and faithfulness in serving her Lord and Savior. Caryl attended school in White Oak and Longview. Fifty-one years ago, she married the love of her life, Joe B. Pinson. A daughter was born and named Eve, because she was born in the evening.
