Irmtraut Pohl, 85, of Longview passed away Saturday Afternoon in Montgomery, Texas. A Mass of Christian burial will be held at 10 AM Wednesday, January 5, 2011 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Longview with Father Gavin Vaverek officiating. A Rosary will be recited in the Chapel of Rader Funeral Home of Longview at 6 PM Tuesday, January 4. The family will receive friends following the Rosary until 8 PM.

Irmtraut was born on April 26, 1925, in Witzhausen, Germany. She moved from Germany to America in 1953 and co-founded Bio-Derm Laboratories in 1971 where she worked and retired.
