**F**uneral services for Charles M. Crouch, 93, of Longview will be held at 2 PM Monday, July 2, 2012 in the Chapel of Rader Funeral Home of Longview with Reverend Melvin Kempfer and Reverend Caleb Crouch officiating. Burial will follow in Rosewood Park in Longview. Mr. Crouch passed away Friday afternoon in a local hospital. The family will receive friends Sunday evening from 6-8 PM at the funeral home.

After graduating from the University of Texas with a degree in Mathematics he proudly served his country in the US Army Air Corps in Counter Intelligence.
