## **Garland Baldwin**

**S**ammie Garland Clawson Paine Baldwin, 97, of Longview passed away February 26, 2013. She was born October 22, 1915 in Dallas, to the late Salmon McKay Smith and Thomas Garland Clawson. Garland was raised in Dallas, Texas and graduated from TWU in Denton, Texas. She was very artistic and while working in Dallas at the Cokesbury Book Store she and a friend illustrated and published a book. Garland married Henry Carlton Paine and they had one son, Stephen Henry Paine. Henry preceded Garland in death in 1960. She then married Kenneth Baldwin, Sr. and they lived in Longview where Ken worked for Texas Eastman.

Garland was a very unique and intelligent individual. She was a member of the Hughey Crest Garden Club and was a diligent horticulturist. Her garden was always filled with the latest and most distinctive types of plants. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Longview for 57 years. Her heart was always with the church and she served as a Deacon and Elder for many years.
