Also started the first drill team at Longview High School in the mid 1040's called the Loboettes. She then taught science and P.E. for many years at Foster Jr. High. She is remembered with fondness by students and friends. Mable Joiner was a long standing member of the Winterfield United Methodist Church where she was dearly loved by many members.
