A lifetime resident of Longview, Ricky was born March 3, 1962, to Robert and Mary Jo Leath. He graduated from Pine Tree ISD in 1980, and from Texas A&M University in 1984 .

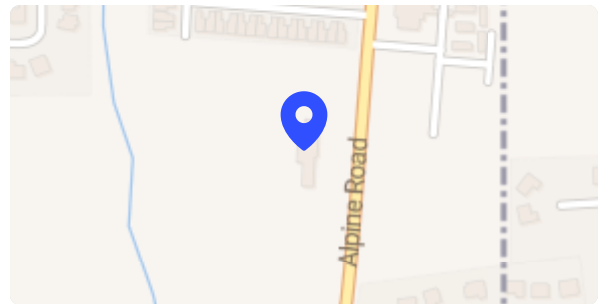

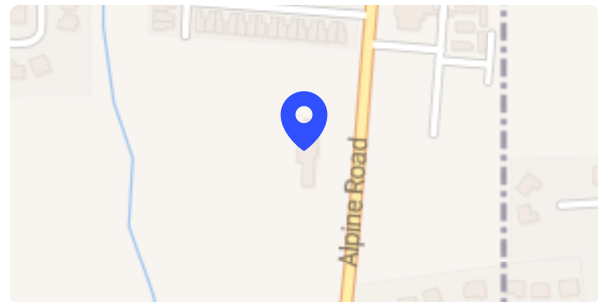

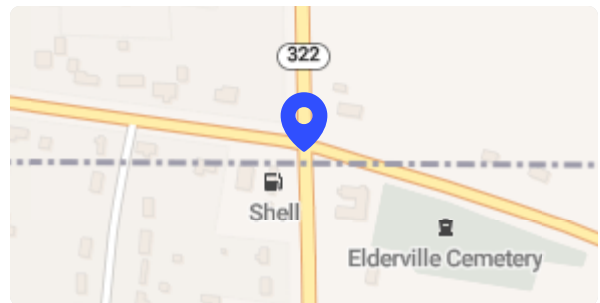
