The family will receive friends at the funeral home from 6-8p.m. Thursday March 6, 2014.



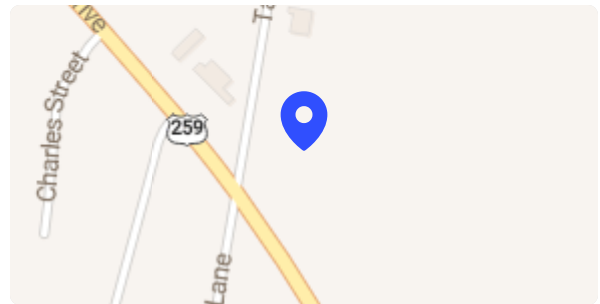

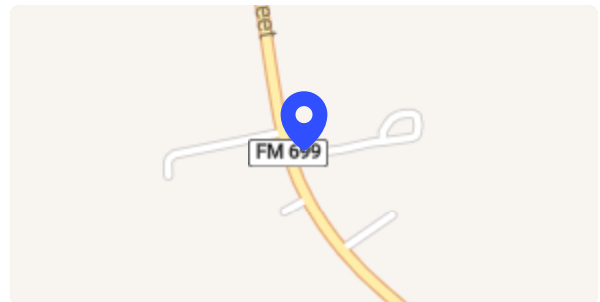
