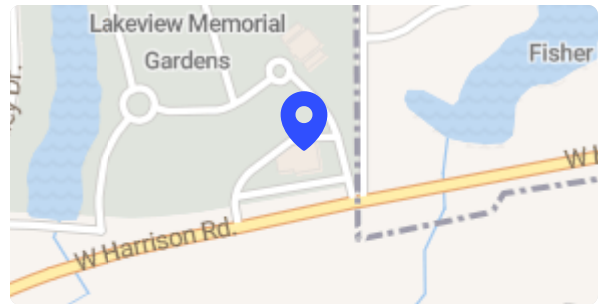
The family wishes to thank the medical staff at the Longview VA Clinic and the Veteran's Hospital in Shreveport, Louisiana for the excellent care he received for many years.
