At about the age of nine, Clara moved with her parents and siblings from New London, Texas to Henderson, Texas where she lived the rest of her life. 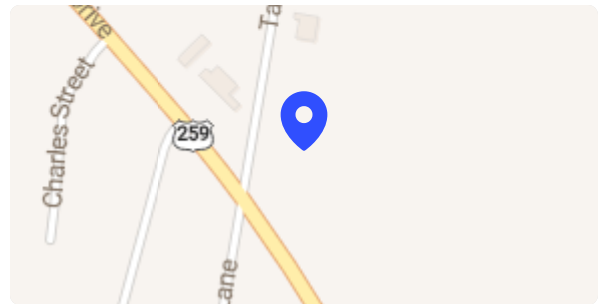

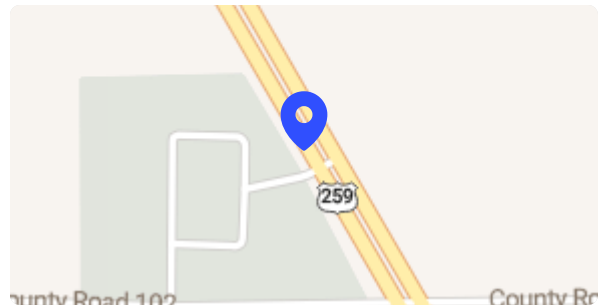
