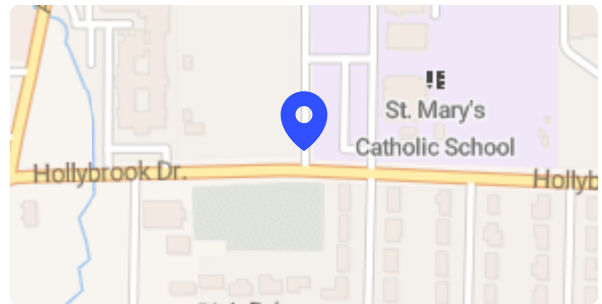

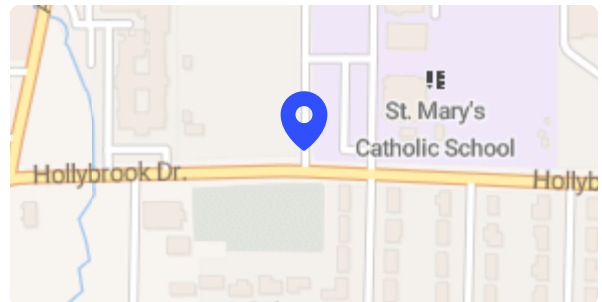


Mass of Christian Burial
