Pallbearers will be, Stanley Mayhan, Corey Puckett, Steve Smith, Lee Armstrong, Larry Gonzales and Tony Baxter






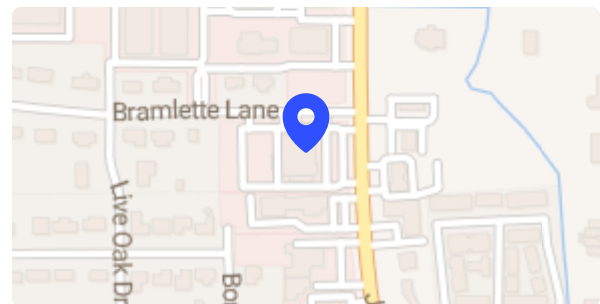

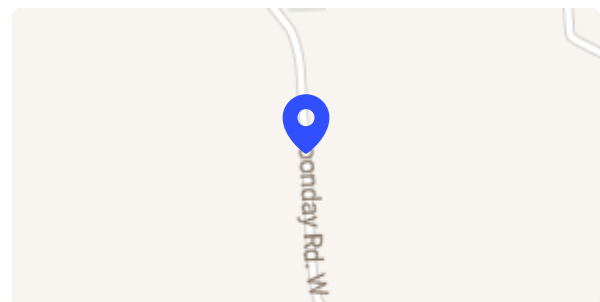
