Gus L. Brown, age 87 of the Chickenfeather Community, was born March 26, 1929 to William T. and Mary Katherine Brown in Chickenfeather, and died August 17, 2016 in Longview after battling Alzheimer's disease for 22 years. Mr. Brown was a native of Henderson, an Army Veteran, and retired from Eastman Kodak in Longview after of 30 years of service where he was a Division Shipping Manager. 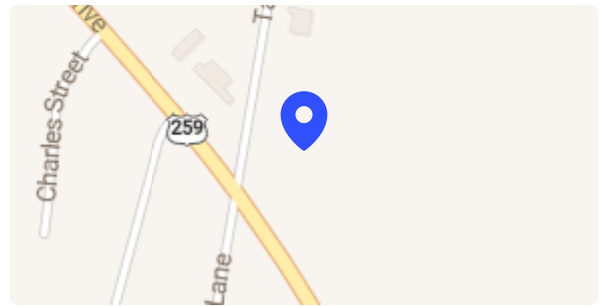
