**T**erry Fisher drew closer to God when she passed from this temporary life on June 14, at the age of 76. Now, she lives eternally with our Father and His Son Jesus Christ. Even as her departure from this earthly life drew near, she lived each moment as an assignment and opportunity to share Jesus. Well done, good and faithful servant.

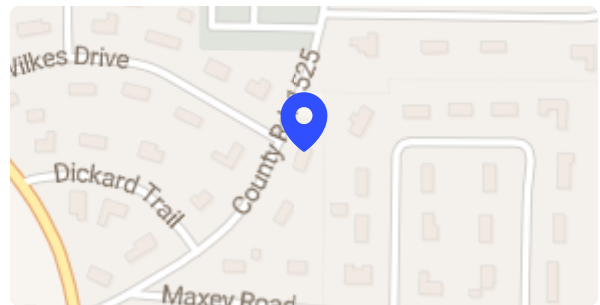
