Hugh William "Bill" Burd, age 98 of Henderson, TX, went home to be with the Lord on July 5, 2017. Burd was born February 5, 1919 in Pine Hill, TX to Charles Henry Burd and Lovie Lee Brooks Burd. He served his country during WWII in the U.S. Army at Camp Barkeley near Abilene, TX. While there, he met and fell in love with Doris Ruth Gilmore. They were married on January 16, 1945 in Henderson, TX. After Burd left the army, he and his wife built their family in Henderson having two children, Loyd William Burd and Patricia Ruth Burd Hitt. Burd worked for many years at the Alford Dairy and later Henderson Clay and was a member of Ebenezer Baptist Church most of his life. He was well known, respected and loved by many. 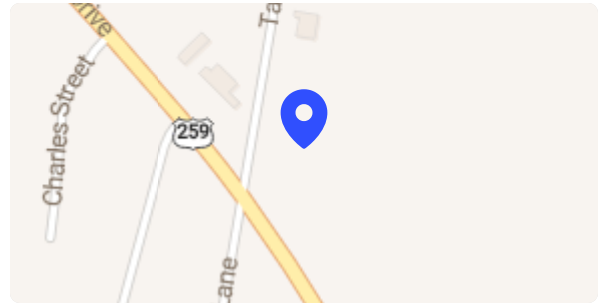

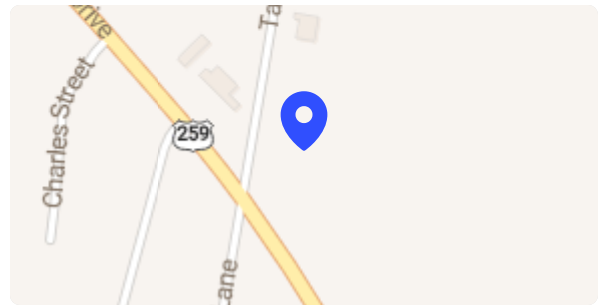
