Heath Abram Faucheux, son of Dion and Michelle, brother to Nathan and Trent Faucheux, was born on March 20th of 2001 in Effingham, Illinois. He was enrolled in Hallsville High School where he was a member of the National Honor Society and The Hallsville Bobcat Band. During marching season he was constantly practicing his French Horn music and his marching steps. His love for music included anything from Jazz, Show Tunes, Big Band, classic hits, and Christian songs. If he wasn't thinking of an "idea" to build something, he had music playing in his mind and would sit at the piano or with his harmonica to play his own and recently taught himself to play trumpet. He was on the Hallsville Math Science Team and competed in Academic UIL since 6th grade. Heath always woke up early for those Saturday morning events with a smile and was ready to go compete and earned many medals. He was also a Tae Kwon Do 1st Degree Black Belt and recently was certified as an American Red Cross Life Guard.

Heath's greatest passion was Boy Scouts where he'd started as a Tiger Cub, earned his Arrow of Light and was only lacking completion of his project for the Tyler Discovery Center to earn his Eagle Scout. He knew all his knots, cooking skills, fire building, first aid and enjoyed teaching these skills to younger Scouts not only for our Troop, but as a staff member for National Youth Leadership Training Camp, Cub Day Camp and Camporee. He was an outstanding leader and served in several roles in his Troop including Senior Patrol Leader, Troop Guide and recently its Bugler. He conquered peaks of Mount Baldy at Philmont, Guadalupe in Texas and Baldy Mountain in Sequoia National Park in California. Whether it was climbing, knee boarding, rappelling, kayaking, canoeing, swimming, shooting guns, archery and especially sailing; he loved adventure and would attempt any challenge that interested him.

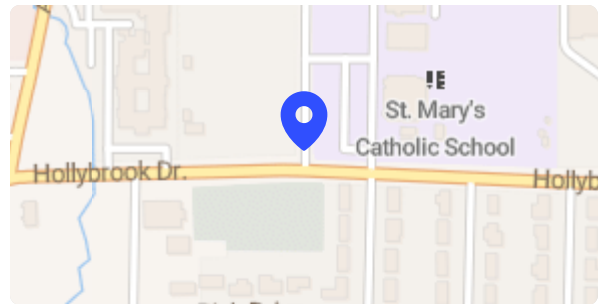

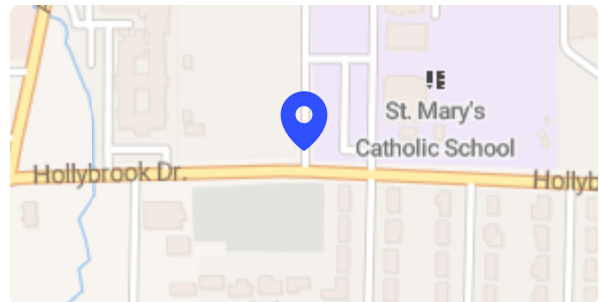

Heath knew how to be a friend- to students or teachers. He always shared the best of himself while pulling from everyone the best in themselves. He taught a class period for me with a photo slideshow and with two friends as backup all about survival skills, Scouts, hypothermia, and Philmont. He helped me arrange my classroom to best benefit students for my lesson plan. He reached out to my own children; befriended my son and drew my painfully shy daughter out of her shell when he entered the classroom. One day Heath was solving a rubrics cube at lunch in my classroom when a crowd of four or five girls swarmed around him captivated. When I teased him, along with one of his buddies he blushed bright red. I told him that he had them all right where he wanted them. He blushed, smirked, and chuckled. He took time at a UIL picnic to visit with me. I hadn't realized how worried I was about being there, which was not typical for me, until listening to Heath calmed me down. Heath was like that. He noticed moods and was a thermostat not a thermometer. If he felt someone needed something, in my case a sense of belonging at that event, Heath didn't wait for someone else to meet a need. He offered me ideas to "improve" my lessons when I asked. He really thought about how to increase excitement and the needs of others in respect to the lesson! He helped students who might feel lost in the content. He had integrity, a servants heart, and an amazing sense of humor and compassion. He would occasionally come in my room before school during tutorials just to see if I needed copies, materials sorted, or to laugh. He would crack a joke and waggle his eyebrows. As a teacher, I will miss his intellect, servant leadership, and enthusiasm. As a mom, I will miss his outreach to my two children. As a friend, I will deeply miss his friendship and humor. I am someone Heath's life touched and I am- my family is- richer for having known him. Two years was not long enough.
