The family will receive friends Monday night from 6-8pm at Rader Funeral Home of Henderson.

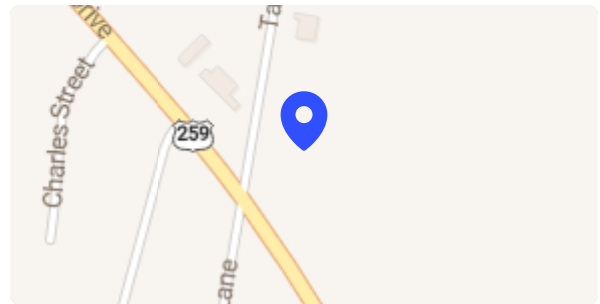

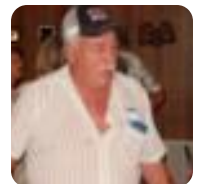
