He will be remembered as a kind, loving, and generous man with a good sense of humor.

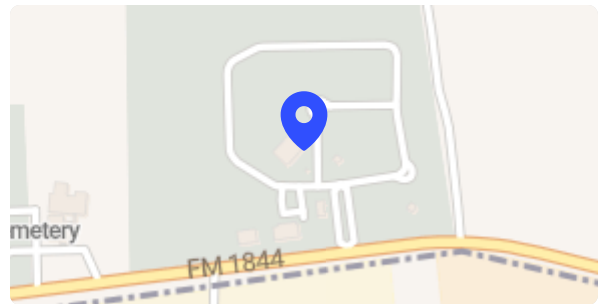

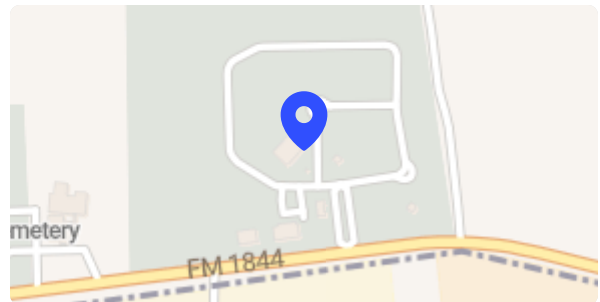

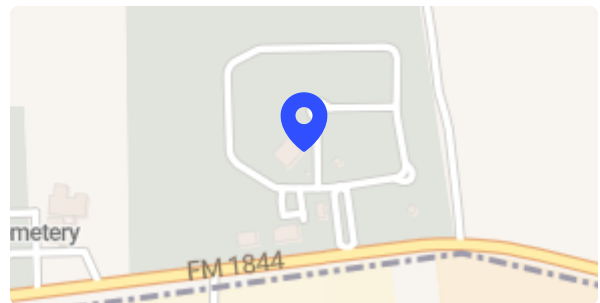
