## **Pastor Larry Lanphier**

**O**n August 23, 2018, Pastor Larry Lanphier, husband, father, papa, brother, pastor and friend, passed away unexpectedly at the age of 68. Larry was born April 16, 1950 to Zettie and Callie Lanphier in Corpus Christi, Texas.

He met and then married his wife of 46 years, Dollie, on June 10, 1972. He was in the Air Force and they were stationed in Wiesbaden, West Germany for 3 years where their daughter, Lori, was born.

After 8 years of military service, Larry pastored several churches in South Texas and worked as a dental lab technician. Larry was currently the lead pastor of Increase Church in White Oak, TX, formerly known as White Oak First Assembly of God. Larry loved people! He loved helping people and ministering to them. He will be greatly missed.
