Frances Eleanor Dry Boyd died September 9, 2018 at home following a short illness and a long fulfilling life.

Frances was born October 25, 1930 in Jacksonville, Texas to James Carrol and Mattie Belle (Bush) Dry and was welcomed into the family by big sister, Kathryn Jane, who was her only sibling.

Marshall Texas became home to the Dry family in the early 1930's and Frances attended Marshall Schools from 1st grade until graduating in 1948; afterward attending East Texas Baptist College. Her High School friends were very special to Frances, lasting through the years- Flo, Elaine, Glo; and until her death.

In Junior High School, Frances met the love of her life, Edward Hall Boyd Jr. They were married Feb 1st 1953 in the First Methodist Church in Marshall and their family grew over the next few years.

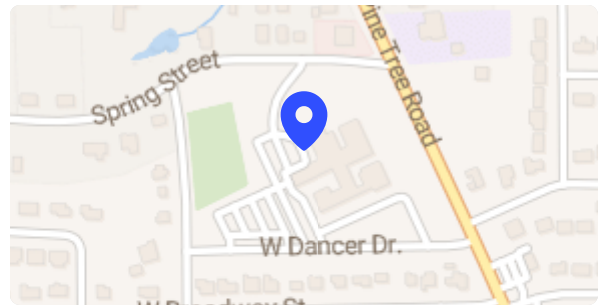

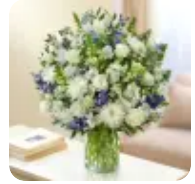
