A time of celebration will follow the mass at El Relicario in Gladewater beginning at 1:30pm then the burial at the Gladewater Memorial Park at 3pm. A time of fellowship will be held at Rader Funeral Home of Longview on Friday from 6pm-8pm. Mr. Martinez went to be with the Lord in the early morning of June 29th, 2019.

Felix Martinez was born on May 26th, 1950 in Mexico to parents Jose and Ramona Martinez. He moved to America in 1976 when he got a job at Fleetwood's in Henderson, and was soon joined by his wife and children. Upon leaving Fleetwood's, Felix used the experience there and started his company, Mobile Home Service out of Gladewater, which he has owned and operated for over 40 years. In his later years, Felix took his love of rodeos and started El Relicario.

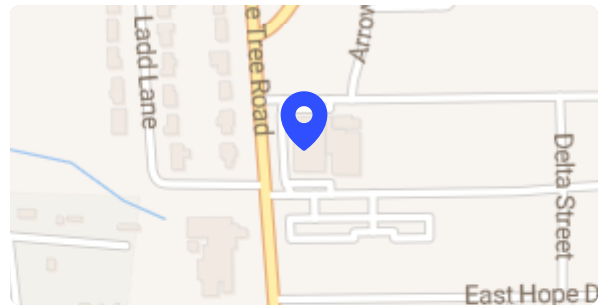
