**P**eggy Elaine Dolive, 58, passed away on July 17, 2019 in her home. Peggy was born on April 4, 1961 in Honolulu, Hawaii to Betty Jean and the late Lt. Col. Robert Daniel Payne. Her father's military service took them to many states until finally settling in Longview in 1972.

Peggy attended Longview High School and received a degree in early childhood education with honors from the University of North Texas. She taught school in Waxahachie ISD, substituted in Longview ISD, and taught at First Christian Church Prep School.

In 1984, Peggy married junior high sweetheart Brian Dolive also of Longview. They enjoyed 35 loving years together. Together they had two children, Emily and Daniel. She spent most of her life as a homemaker, the most important job of raising her two children.

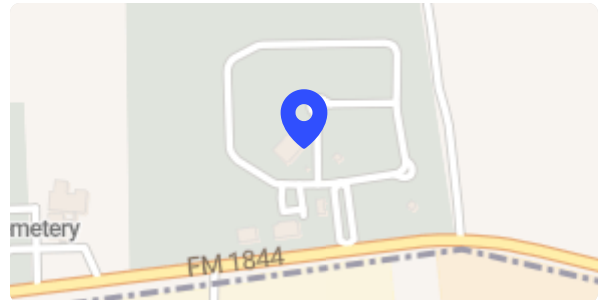
