# Allison Williams

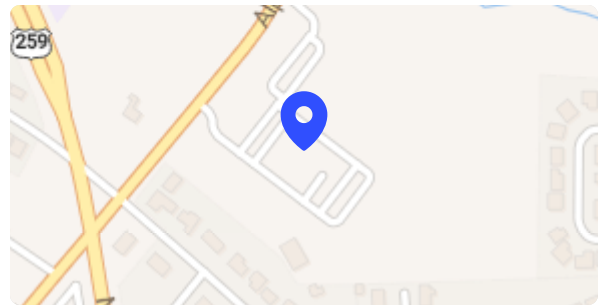
AUG 27, 1977 - AUG 21, 2019
