Carl A. Barton died September 23, 2019. He was born May 13, 1942 in Abbeville, Louisiana. 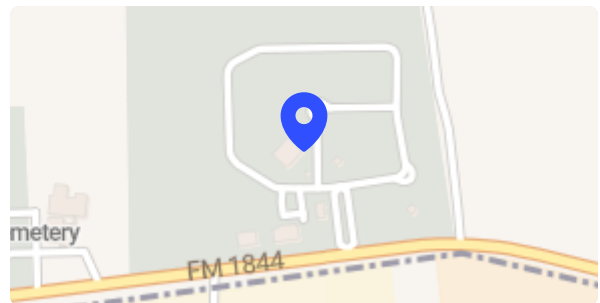
