A celebration of her life will be held Friday, February 28, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. at Trinity Baptist Church, Lakeport, TX.

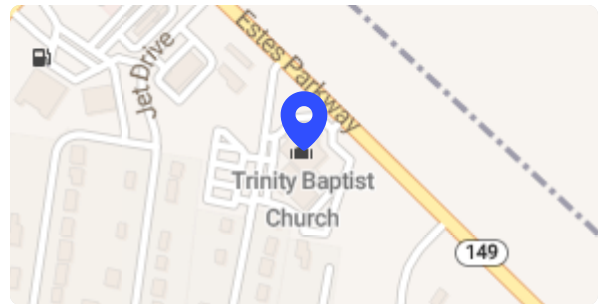
