**B**illie Ruth Fulmer, 89, was born on September 11, 1931 in Jefferson, Texas to James Calvin Roberts and Nerva Kiser Roberts. She passed away at home on Friday, October 30, 2020 after a long illness.

She grew up in Jefferson, Marshall, and Dallas and graduated from Crozier Tech High School in Dallas.

Billie was living and working in Shreveport, LA when she met Milton A. Fulmer who was in the Air Force and stationed at Barksdale Air Force Base. 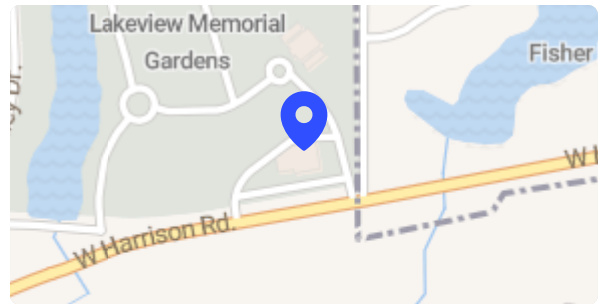

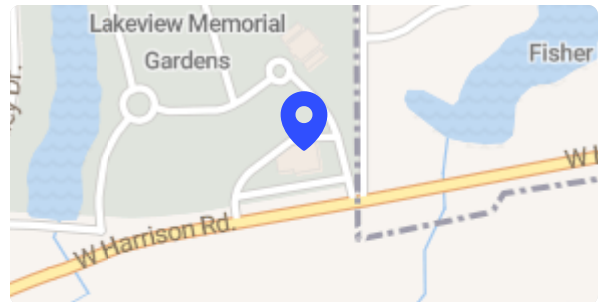
