Mr. Harrell was born May 29, 1924, in Waco, Texas to his parents Walter and Eula Harrell and passed away on March 30, 2021 in Longview, Texas.

Hugh was a World War II veteran where he served his country as a surgical tech in Paris, France. After the war, he graduated in 1950 with his law degree from Baylor University. In 1951, Hugh moved to Lubbock, Texas to set up his law practice. He enjoyed his law practice there from 1951-2014. In 1969, Hugh earned his doctorate of law. He participated in the community serving on the Board of Directors at GirlsTown located in Whiteface, Texas, and was active in the Lubbock Kiwanis Club. Later, he assisted young law students by holding Mock Court at Texas Tech University.

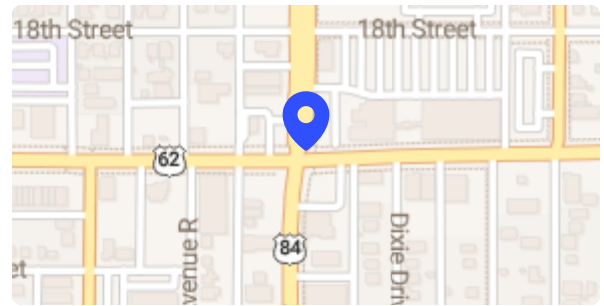
