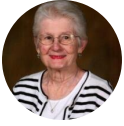


Martha Ann Bonham

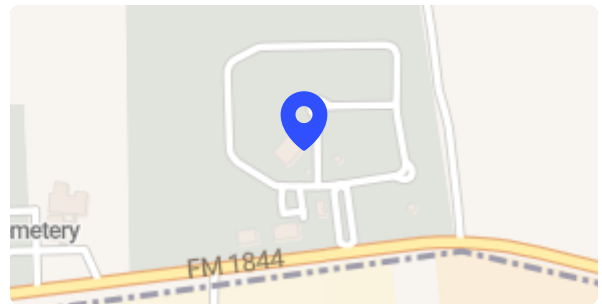

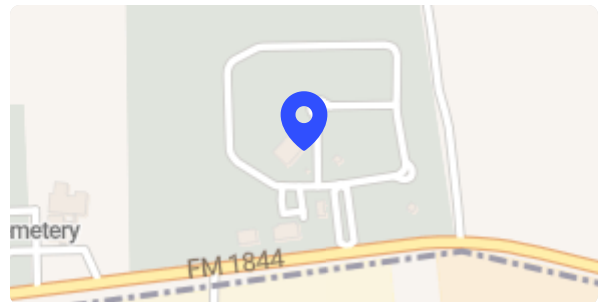

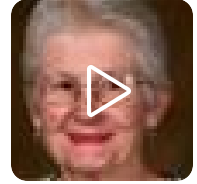
