Ron was born to Rufus and Ann Doss in Longview on October 9, 1956. 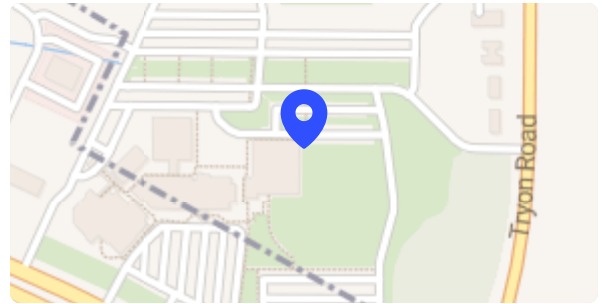

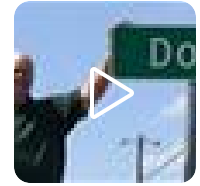
