Ronnie “Ron” David Hart, 73, was called to his eternal home on June 9, 2022. Ron was born in Lufkin, TX on September 23, 1948. After graduating from South Oak Cliff High School in 1967, he joined the U.S. Navy in 1968, where he served for 4 years. After his military service, he worked as a contractor in Plano, TX. At the age of 31, Ron accepted Christ as his personal Savior and later attended the Criswell Center for Biblical Studies.
