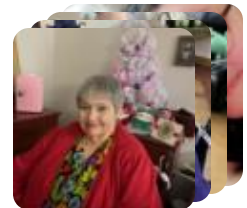


Amanda Shelton shared 4 photos to the **Tribute Wall** album.
