## Mr. Allen Glenn Haney

JAN 9, 1932 - APR 5, 2023

**O**n April 5, 2023, Allen Glenn Haney closed his eyes at his home in Longview, Tx, for -the last time only to open them again in the presence of his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, with a perfectly healed body and mind. Glenn Haney, known so dearly as “Glennpa” to his grandchildren, was surrounded by his family and their sweet singing as he entered into Heaven with a single tear rolling down his face. He was 91 years old.

Funeral service for Allen Glenn Haney will be held 10 am Saturday April 8, 2023 in the chapel of Rader Funeral Home of Longview with Bro. Wayne Spanhanks and Bro. Joe McGraw officiating. A graveside service will be held at 1pm at Smyrna Cemetery in Wood County. The family will receive friends Friday April 7th from 5-7pm at Rader Funeral Home of Longview.

Glenn, “Glennpa” Haney was born on January 9, 1932, to Cleve and Winnie Haney in Panola County/Carthage, Tx. After high school in Carthage, he joined the Army and served his country in the Korean Conflict. Upon returning home he went to technical school and became a master electrician with State of Texas electrical license, working all over East Texas. It was in this work that he stopped to have lunch at The Ideal Grill in Winnsboro, Tx, and met the love of his life, Margaret Elaine Whitworth, his “PRECIOUS” as he always called her.

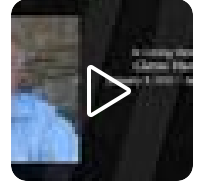

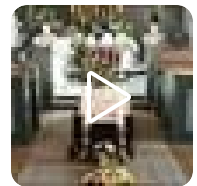
