Malcolm Wesley "Rusty" Brumit passed away peacefully with family at his side on January 21, 2024, after a lengthy battle with Parkinson's disease. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 31 years, Suzanne.

Born in Dallas, Texas, on November 5, 1943, to Malcolm and Edna Mae Brumit, he was the oldest of four boys. Rusty graduated from Sunset High School in 1961, where he discovered his love of music and drumming. He attended Hardin Simmons University in Abilene before joining the United States Navy, where he proudly served as a telecommunications specialist in the Vietnam War.

Rusty was a Godly man and did his best to serve Him during his time on earth. He loved music and enjoyed cooking, taking great pride in his go-to favorite, spaghetti with homemade meat sauce. 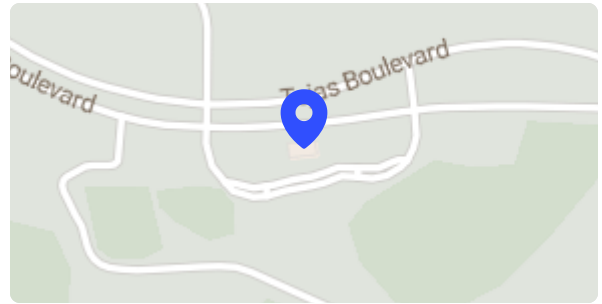

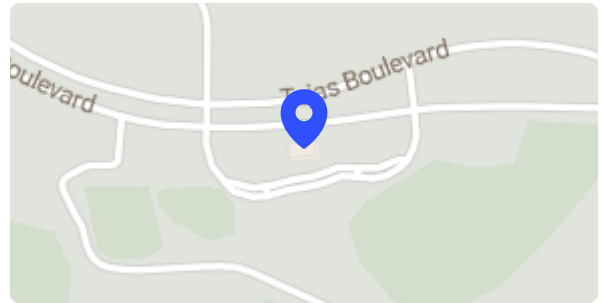
