Darlene Stamp Wooten, 88, passed away June 15, 2024 in Longview, Texas. She was born August 23, 1935 in Lewis, Iowa to Alfred and Ethel (Jipsen) Stamp. Darlene grew up in Southwest Iowa where she graduated from Lewis Highschool in 1953. In high school she played basketball and was very involved in 4-H. At 17, she was elected State President of Iowa Girls 4-H Clubs at their state convention. Darlene excelled at sewing, cooking, gardening, canning and other domestic arts.

She attended Northwest Missouri State College where she pledged Tri-Sigma Sorority and was soon "pinned" to her fraternity brother Lester Dean Wooten. They married May 27, 1956 in Atlantic, Iowa and were happily married for 62 years before his death in 2017. They enjoyed going on cruises, hosting large holiday family gatherings, watching their grandchildren play sports, and fellowshiping with their life-long friends in the Golden Eagles.

Darlene taught elementary school, raised 4 children, assisted her husband in his work in the insurance industry, and later served as a pastor's wife and mother figure to many at Longview Christian Fellowship Church.

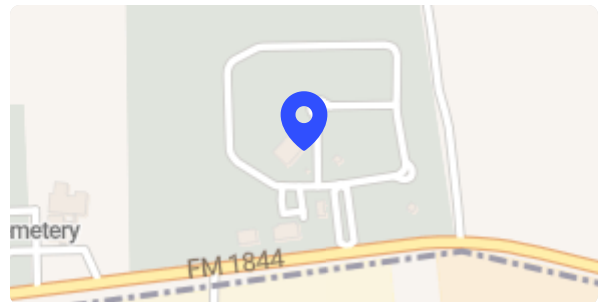
