# Joelyn Elizabeth Phillips

FEB 24, 1935 - JUN 11, 2025

Joelyn Elizabeth Phillips went to be with our Lord and Savior on June 11, 2025, lovingly surrounded by her family. Joelyn was born on February 24, 1935 in Mangum, Oklahoma to Joe and Louise Andress. She was the eldest of three children with a brother, Don, and a sister, Francille. She spent her childhood in the Borger, Texas area where she attended school and also where she gave her life to Jesus. While in high school, she met the love of her life, Tommy Jack Phillips. The two married on June 5, 1953, one week after her graduation from high school, and began their 68 year marriage together before Tommy passed in 2021.

Joelyn and Tommy lived a full and adventurous life, making homes in Pampa and Perryton, Texas, Casper, Wyoming, Lakewood, Colorado, Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, and finally settling in Longview to be close to family. 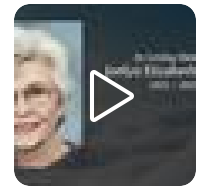
